REGULATIONS

TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. The competition is open to composers of all nationalities and ages.
2. Only works that have been written after 2003 may be submitted.
3. Works that have been awarded at other competitions cannot be submitted.
4. Participants may submit more than one entry.

COMPOSITIONS

1. The following types of compositions will be considered: string quartet, works for violin and piano, cello and piano, oboe and piano, clarinet and piano, voice and piano and piano duet (four hands and two pianos).
2. The text in a piece for voice and piano may be in any language. An English translation must be included.
3. The use of tape and live electronics will not be permitted.
4. The length of the work must be between 15 and 30 minutes.

PRIZES

1. Three prizes will be awarded:
 - First Prize, 25 000 Zloty* (ca. 7 000 Euro), sponsored by the Polish Ministry of Culture and National Heritage.
 - Second Prize, 2 500 Euro*, sponsored by Chester Music Ltd. / Novello & Co. Ltd.
 - Third Prize, 5 000 Zloty* (ca. 1 500 Euro), sponsored by The Witold Lutosławski Society.
 - In addition, the jury will select three honourable mentions.
2. The jury may divide the prizes differently.
3. The decisions of the jury are final.

SUBMISSIONS

1. A score should be submitted anonymously and marked with an alias.
2. A sealed envelope, marked with the same alias should accompany the score and include the following information:
 - the composer full name
 - date and place of birth
 - nationality and citizenship
 - gender
 - postal address, telephone and fax numbers and e-mail address
 - title and length of the composition.
3. Scores should be sent to the following address:

4. The deadline for submission of scores is 15 November 2008. The postmark is decisive.
5. The results of the competition will be announced on 15 December 2008.

ENTRY FEE

1. An entry fee of 40 Euro per score should be made payable by transfer or money order to account number PL11 1240 1037 1978 0010 0182 9201 at Bank Pekao S.A., SWIFT CODE: PKOPPLPW.
Bank charges are the responsibility of the sender; if the sender pays less than 40 Euro the score would not be accepted. We do not honour cheques.
2. Receipt of payment must be enclosed with the submission.
3. The entry fee is non-refundable.

FINAL DECISIONS

1. Participants are subject to the regulations of the competition.
2. Scores not meeting these regulations will not be considered.
3. Contentious cases will be resolved based on the Polish version of the Regulations of the Competition.
4. Submissions will be returned only at the special request of the participants and at their cost.
